

RESIDENT PARKING DECAL AFFIRMATION STATEMENT VEHICLE REGISTERED IN A BUSINESS NAME

On April 25, 2017, §12-131 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Myrtle Beach, South Carolina was amended to permit the issuance of resident parking decals to business vehicles of city residents under certain affirmations. "When a resident is the owner of a business licensed in the City, and uses a business vehicle that is registered in the City as their sole personal vehicle, the resident business owner or owners shall be entitled to a decal after affirmation that they reside in the city, that they are the owner of the business, that the business is licensed in the city, and vehicle tax is paid to the city for that vehicle for which the decal is sought. When a licensed group home or resident home uses a vehicle to transport residents of the City that reside in that group or resident home, and that vehicle is subject to the payment of vehicle tax to the City, that vehicle shall be entitled to a decal."
